MEMBERSHIP OF MELBOURNE UNIVERSITY FOOTBALL CLUB, Inc (MUFC)
Information on Membership in Question & Answer format

1. I am a 'member' of University Blacks or University Blues. That means I am automatically a member of the Melbourne University Football Club.
A: No. Both University Blacks and University Blues are divisions of the Melbourne University Football Club, Inc ABN 21 729 266 145 and are not legal entities in their own right. They are not due to the MU Sport requirement of 'one club for one sport'. So one is a member of the MUFC (refer 7 below).
2. I am a member of Melbourne University Sport. That means I am automatically a member of the Melbourne University Football Club.
A: No. The methodology shown below in item 7 is the only way to become a member.
3. I have been here for a number of years. This procedure has not been followed previously.
A: Correct. The Board of the MUFC has directed that this procedure be followed to ensure compliance with our own 'constitution' and for communication purposes.
4. It is neither important nor relevant.
A: The concept of the MUFC without a proper members register has possible implications, not necessarily limited to the use of facilities, the jumper, liquor licensing requirements and insurance.
5. It will cost me.
A: No necessarily. A fee will be paid to the MUFC by either the Blacks or Blues on your behalf. This fee is set from year to year.
6. I want to see the full constitution / statement of purposes.
A: Sure. It can be viewed and downloaded at www.melbunifootball.com
7. What are the relevant rules regarding membership?
A: Sections 4-6 provide:
4. APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP
 - (1) A natural person who is or is eligible to become a member of the Melbourne University Sports Association and is approved for membership as provided in these Rules is eligible to become a Member on payment of the annual subscription.
 - (2) A nomination of a person for membership of the Club: -
 - (a) Shall be made in writing by any of the Teams in the form as determined by the Board from time to time;
 - (b) Shall be lodged with the General Secretary; and
 - (c) Shall be accompanied by the sum payable as the annual subscription.
 - (3) As soon as practicable after the receipt of a nomination and the annual subscription, the nomination shall be referred in the first instance to the President and the General Secretary.
 - (4) Upon a nomination be referred to the President and General Secretary, the President and the General Secretary shall determine (by agreement with each other) whether to approve or reject the nomination. If the nomination is approved, the General Secretary shall enter the nominee's name in the Register of Members kept by him and upon the name being so entered, the nominee becomes a member.
 - (5) If the President and the General Secretary do not agree whether to approve or reject the nomination or if the President and the General Secretary reject a nomination, the nomination shall then (in the second instance) be referred to the Board. Upon a nomination being referred to the Board, the Board shall determine whether to approve or reject the nomination. If the nomination is approved, the General Secretary shall enter the nominee's name in the Register of Members kept by him and upon the name being so entered, the nominee becomes a member.
 - (6) If the nomination is rejected by the Board, the General Secretary shall, with as little delay as possible, notify the nominee in writing that his nomination was not approved for membership of the Club and return payment of the annual subscription
 - (7) A right, privilege or obligation of a person by reason of his membership of the Club: -
 - (a) is not capable of being transferred or transmitted to another person; and
 - (b) terminates upon cessation of his membership whether by death, resignation, failure to renew or otherwise.
5. LIFE MEMBERS
Notwithstanding anything contained in clause 4, a person may be appointed by the Board as a Life Member. In order to be recommended for appointment as a Life Member a person must have given no less than eight years outstanding service to the Club as a Member of the Board or a Committee or Team Player, including three years service in an administrative capacity. Upon appointment, a Life Member shall be presented with a medallion by the Board.
6 HONORARY MEMBERS
Notwithstanding anything contained in clause 4, the Board may, in special circumstance, admit as an Honorary Member any person whom it deems fit. Such membership is current for the financial year in which such membership was granted.
